Challenge: Zoom in to make it a cropped composition.

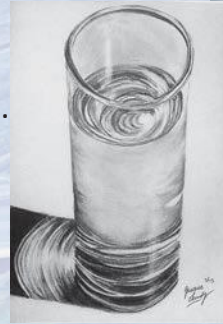


Task 2: Record a shoe

Challenge: Consider an interesting composition.

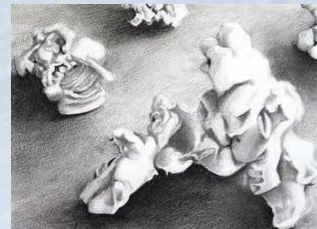
Task 3: Record a piece of paper with lettering on, crumpled up.

Task 4: Record a glass half full with water.

Challenge: Add a spoon to the glass.



KEY TIPS

- Always sketch out lightly
- Make sure you feather your lines.
- Always use a sharp 2B pencil
- Look at the space around the object, as well as the object itself to help you get an accurate shape.
- Lean on a piece of paper to avoid smudging your work.
- Study your object in detail, observing it closely
- Avoid smudging.
- Spend at least 1 hour on each drawing minimum.
- Remember to add highlights with a rubber or leave the lightest area blank.
- Don't forget a shadow
- Always use a range of darker and lighter tones.
