The Appleton School congratulates the summer 2022 Sixth Formers on their A-Level and BTEC examinations.



We could not however be more proud of each and every one of our students. The resilience they have shown in achieving such strong outcomes is remarkable and they are walking away with skillsets and knowledge that will support them achieving at a wide range of top universities. We wish all of them every happiness and success in their university courses or employment opportunities.

Students in our 2022 Year 13 cohort achieved an excellent set of results:

- 100% of students achieved A* - E A-Level passes.
- 95% achieved at least one Distinction grade level at BTEC Level 3.
- 58.5% of students achieved A* - B (including equivalents).
- The average Academic grade was C+.
- The average Applied General grade was a Distinction+.
- 93% of students who applied for university secured their top choice universities.
- 22% of students gained a place at a prestigious Russell Group University.
- 46% of Year 13 students went to university, 54% found employment, gained an apprenticeship or continued with further training.
- 92% Academic Retention rate, 100% Applied General Retention rate in Year 13 (the percentage of students who get to the end of their study programme).

Highlighting the breadth of talent at the school, students are progressing onto diverse university courses such as Law, Economics, Anthropology, Psychology, English Literature, Robotics, Chemistry and Zoology. There were also a number of impressive individual performances, for example:

Natasha Cooper and Ioana Gordea both received outstanding grades this year. Natasha will be studying Law next year at Queen Marys University of London after achieving a number of the highest possible grades she could as an A-Level student at The Appleton School. She earned an A* grade in three of her subjects; English, Psychology and Sociology as well as an A grade in History. Ioana will be studying Management at the University of St Andrews. Ioanna achieved an A* in Business, two A grades in German and Psychology and a grade B in English.



Alastair Munday achieved an impressive three A* grades in Business, Law and Psychology as an A-Level student at The Appleton School. Alastair will be studying Anthropology at Durham University.



Reece Howard also received outstanding results this year. He achieved three A* grades in Physics, Mathematics and Further Maths and is going onto complete a degree apprenticeship in Civil Engineering with WSP London.
