The Appleton School congratulates the summer 2024 Sixth Formers on their A-Level and BTEC examinations.



We could not however be more proud of each and every one of our students. The resilience they have shown in achieving such strong outcomes is remarkable and they are walking away with skillsets and knowledge that will support them achieving at a wide range of top universities. We wish all of them every happiness and success in their university courses or employment opportunities.

Students in our 2024 Year 13 cohort achieved an excellent set of results:

- 97% of students achieved A*- E A-Level passes.
- 83% achieved at least one Distinction grade level at BTEC Level 3.
- 51% of students achieved A*- B (including equivalents).
- The average Academic grade was C.
- The average Applied General grade was a Distinction.
- 57 students in our Sixth Form applied to University and were all successful in gaining University places.
- 21% of students gained a place at a prestigious Russell Group University.
- 53% of Year 13 students went to university, 47% found employment, gained an apprenticeship or continued with further training.
- 95.5% Retention rate in Year 13 (the percentage of students who get to the end of their study programme).

Highlighting the breadth of talent at the school, students are progressing onto diverse university courses such as Architecture, Engineering, Sports journalism, Psychology, Biomedicine and Physics with Astrophysics. There were also a number of impressive individual performances, for example:

Lily Charnick received outstanding grades this year. Lily will be studying Accountancy and Finance at the University of Warwick after achieving a number of the highest possible grades she could as an A-Level student at The Appleton School. She earned an A* grade in Business and Psychology and a grade A in Mathematics.



Ewan Guarnieri achieved impressive grades in Mathematics, Physics and English Language alongside EPQ as an A-Level student at The Appleton School. Ewan achieved a grade A* in maths and in his EPQ plus a grade A in Physics and English Language. Ewan will be studying Physics and Philosophy at King's College London.



Abbie Kneller will be studying Law with Business at Queen Mary University of London next year after picking up excellent A-Level results at The Appleton School. She achieved an A* in Business and two A grades in Psychology and Law.



Louis Field also received outstanding results this year. He achieved an A grade in both Maths and Further Maths, a grade B in Computer Science and a grade C in Physics and is going on to the University of York to study Electronic Engineering.



Sian Firth will be studying Biomedicine at King's College London next year after picking up excellent A-Level results at The Appleton School. She achieved two A grades in Biology and Chemistry and a grade B in Mathematics.
