EXAM NOTES:

1. All Mathematics, English, Science, History & Geography exams will take place as a year group either in the sports hall/gym and possibly another couple of other venues around the school. You will be given a timetable for these subjects showing rooms and seat numbers next week. All other exams which show class groups will take place in the classroom during your normal subject lesson.
2. All equipment should be brought to the examination room in a clear, see-through pencil case. All examinations are required to be written in **BLACK** ink – pencils may be used for drawings and diagrams – bring at least 2 of each with you. Ensure you have the correct equipment for **all** examinations including a calculator for those exams where permitted – there will be **NO** spare equipment for loan!
3. Toilet trips will not be permitted early in the exam or near the end because you have finished your paper early and want something to do – make sure you go **BEFORE** your exam!
4. When you are in the sports hall or gym all coats and bags should be stored in the boys changing room which will then be locked. For exams in the main hall, the servery will be used for bag storage.
5. **MOBILE PHONES AND ANY TYPE OF WATCH ARE NOT PERMITTED IN ANY EXAMINATION ROOM.** It is strongly recommended that you hand any unauthorised/valuable items in to the invigilator before you go into the hall.
