Dear Parent/Carer

A reminder that the GCSE written exams begin on Monday.

Morning exams start at 9 am and afternoon exams at 1:45 pm. If your child has a morning exam they should go straight to their exam venue, not to registration. If they are late to an exam they may not be given additional time, so if travelling from a further distance away, please allow sufficient time for minor delays in your travel plans. Those with Access arrangements will start afternoon exams at 1:15 so need to leave their period 4 lesson at 12:45. Students need a **black pen, pencil and ruler for all exams, and a calculator for specific exams.** It is not the school's responsibility to provide these items of equipment.

Once your child has finished a morning exam, they are permitted to go and sit in the canteen for the remainder of period 2. They are not permitted to walk around the school and disturb other lessons. They will be expected to attend lessons period 3 and 4, as per their timetable.

All students are expected to meet these basic regulations during the exam period.
