<i>Unit 1:</i> Complete write up of class notes on practitioners (turning mind-maps and analysis notes) into structured exam notes.

<i>Unit 2:</i> Use our self-reflection tools and booklets to complete critical feedback sheets, setting appropriate targets that can be worked upon outside of lesson time.		
<i>Unit 3:</i> Complete your own independent analysis and interpretation of the set stimulus provided.		
<i>Unit 4:</i> Communicate with appropriate community venues and outreaches in order to secure your own performance placement.
